

Louisiana Music Tour 2003

BOOKING CONDITIONS

DEPOSITS:

Deposit of \$400 per person is due immediately to hold a place on the tour.

Early Bird prices effective through January 15, 2003. Reservations postmarked after this date will be subject to a \$50 booking fee per person.

Balance for the trip is due no later than March 1, 2003.

Prices are based on a minimum of 30 people traveling. The tour price is subject to an increase if numbers fall short of this for the full tour.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

There will be an \$150 cancellation fee prior to January 20, 2003 and a \$400 cancellation fee from January 21 through March 14, 2003.

100% of the tour price will be nonrefundable as of March 15, 2003, although this may be covered by travel and trip cancellation insurance. There can be no partial refund for unused rooms, tickets, etc.

In all cases, notice of cancellation must be made in writing.

ARRIVAL:

For the Full Tour, our first official event will be dinner on Thursday, April 24. We will be departing for the Cajun trip on Monday morning, April 28 at 9:30 AM from the lobby of the Bourbon Orleans Hotel. If you are coming on the "Cajun Only" portion of the trip, you must meet us by this time or you will be responsible for arranging your own transportation to Eunice and joining the tour there. No refund can be made for any activities that you may have missed.

TOUR INCLUDES:

Full Tour (April 24 - May 1) includes all hotels, plus festival tickets and shuttle tickets for any two days of the first weekend of the New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Festival and all events in the Cajun Country. Thursday Extension (May 1) includes hotel only. Second Weekend Add On (May 2 - 5) includes hotel plus tickets for three days of the Jazz Fest and shuttle tickets to the Fairgrounds.

ROOMMATES:

If you are travelling alone, we will try to find a suitable roommate for you. This is usually not a problem. However, if one is not available, you will be required to pay the single supplement of \$650 for the Full Tour, \$80 for the "Cajun Only" trip, \$75 for the Thursday extension and \$300 for the Second Weekend Add On as applicable.

CAJUN COUNTRY ONLY:

Limited space is available for the Cajun Only package. Preference is given to those on the Full Tour. To qualify for the Cajun Only Early Bird price, you must also sign up for the welcome dinner at the Napoleon House (\$65) on Thursday, April 24. Dinner includes a five course meal, all cocktails, wine and gratuities. If you are not attending the dinner, then the Early Bird price is not available and a \$50 surcharge will be added to the cost of the Cajun Only trip.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS & FOOD RESTRICTIONS:

Festival Tours accepts people in good health who are capable of attending the activities we plan. However, it is helpful for us to be aware of your health conditions or allergies, although we cannot take responsibility for them. Whenever possible, we will ask for vegetarian meals if requested. Please be aware that in certain circumstances, such as the barbecue and crawfish boil on the Cajun Tour, there are no alternatives available and you will need to provide alternate food yourself.

RESPONSIBILITY:

The Agent, Tour Operators and their representatives give notice that all tickets and coupons are issued by them and all arrangements for transportation and hotel accommodations, etc. are made by them upon the express condition that they shall not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or irregularity that may be occasioned either by reason of defect in any vehicle or through the acts or default of any company or persons engaged in conveying the passenger. Such conveying, etc. is subject to the laws of the country where provided.

The Agent and its representatives accept no responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delays or changes in service which may be caused by illness, weather, strikes, declared or undeclared war, quarantine or other causes. Such losses or expenses must be borne by the passenger. The right is reserved to amend or revise the routes or schedules listed in the itineraries, or to cancel any portion or all of the tour.

CAJUN TOUR:

Inherent to enjoying the Cajun trip, there are certain health and safety risks. This is part of the enjoyment and excitement of this type of adventure travel. We will be visiting private homes, traveling on privately owned boats and by other means of transportation. We may come in contact with local wildlife, including alligators. We will be eating home cooked foods and will get a chance to go crawfishing and swimming in unknown waters with unknown creatures and insects.

By signing the "Louisiana Music Tour 2003" Booking Form on the other side, you thereby acknowledge that you are voluntarily participating in these activities and agree to take full responsibility for your participation. By signing, you are aware of the potential hazards and agree not to hold Festival Tours International, or any of the people we meet or visit in Louisiana, responsible should illness, injury, death, property loss or damage occur.

TRAVEL INSURANCE/MEDICAL INSURANCE:

We strongly advise you to protect yourself with Travel Insurance, available from any travel agency. Medical insurance which covers travel to and within Louisiana is required to participate on the tour.
